- Bring a second boat to the pond on “fun race nights” for interested observers to try out.
- Schedule “fun races” at alternate locations throughout the year to expose the Club to a broader population.
- Schedule a Windsor Model Yacht Club seminar @ WYC to promote interest in the sport.
- Investigate a secondary school building/racing competition involving club membership.

## **OTHER CLUB INITIATIVES**

- Formalize a new RG65 class racing schedule.
- Formalize a new EC12 class racing schedule.
- Promote increased participation with Detroit area clubs.
- Promote increased liaison with other Windsor-Essex area model radio control clubs.
- Promote ways in which to recognize Club members who over the years have made significant contributions to the Club and the sport of radio control yachting.
- Investigate the feasibility of hosting sponsored regional and national events; target for 2011 calendar year.
